Hatherop has recently had a Community Speed Watch Camera installed and the local community have been analysing the data so far.

365 vehicle movements exceeding 36mph near the school in a month Highest speed – 51mph Fastest hours 6-7pm Busiest hours 4-5pm

Average offence speed across the day typically: 7-8am 37-38mph Lunchtime 37mph 3-4pm 38-39mph 6-7pm 39-40mph
